A Boxed Luncheon will be available and may be reserved by purchase in advance or on a first-come, first-served basis at the Village Store on the event day.

The Acworth Community Charitable Trust, a tax exempt organization, was founded in 2007 for the purpose of supporting charitable projects benefiting the town of Acworth and its citizens.
